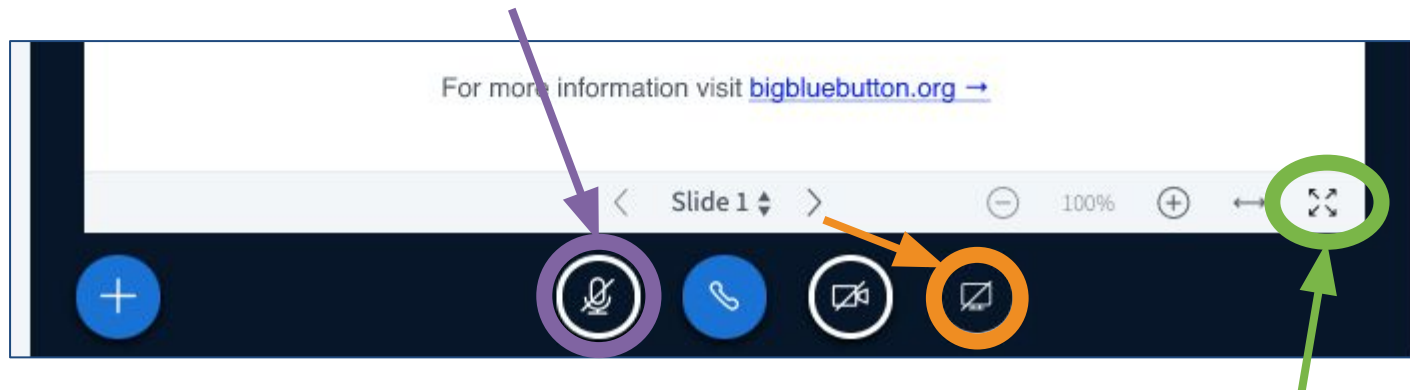

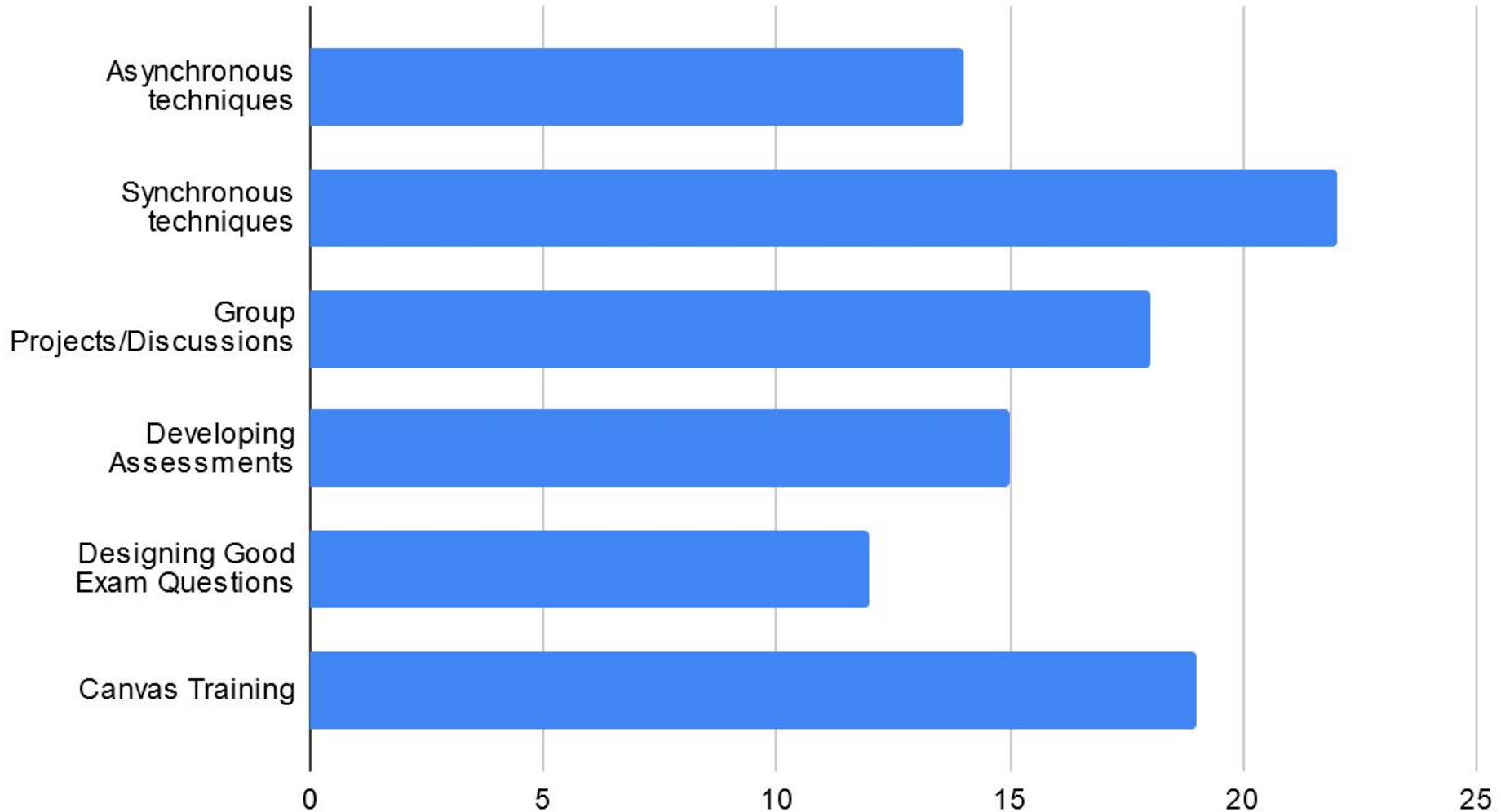


- If the microphone is Blue your audio is on and everyone can hear you.

- If you didn't set up your audio when you came in **click the mic** to do that

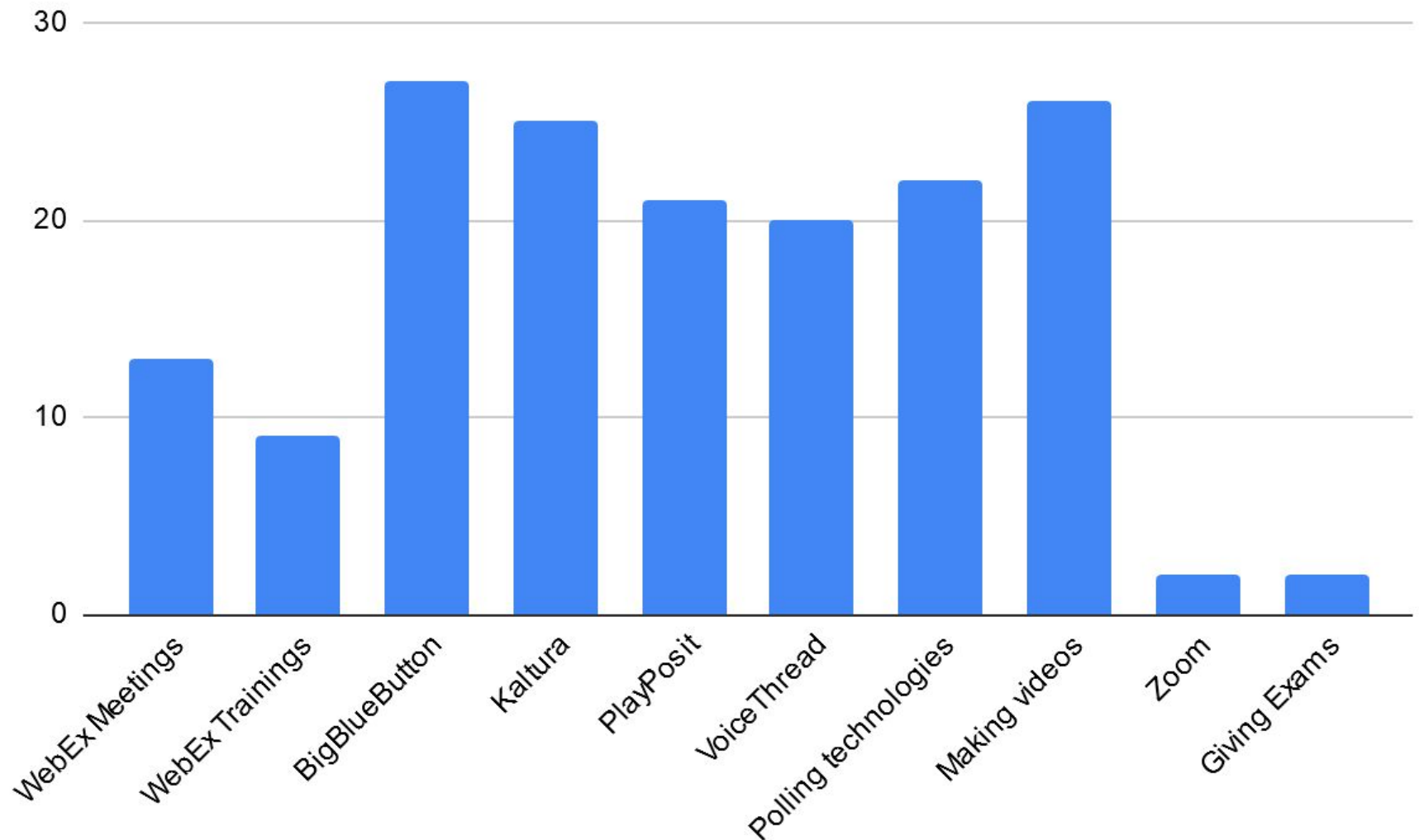


- Click to expand **make the shared screen full size**

- You can use break-out rooms to organize this in an synchronous format



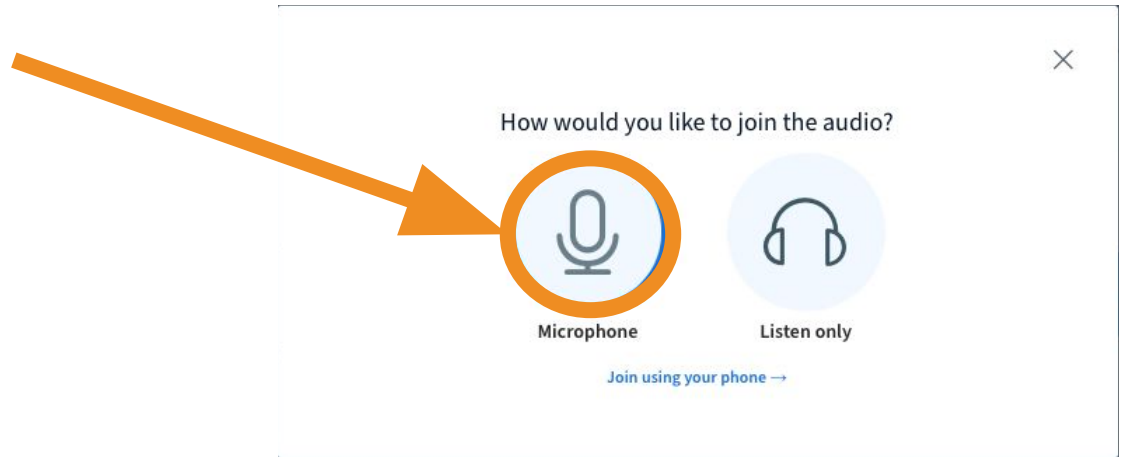

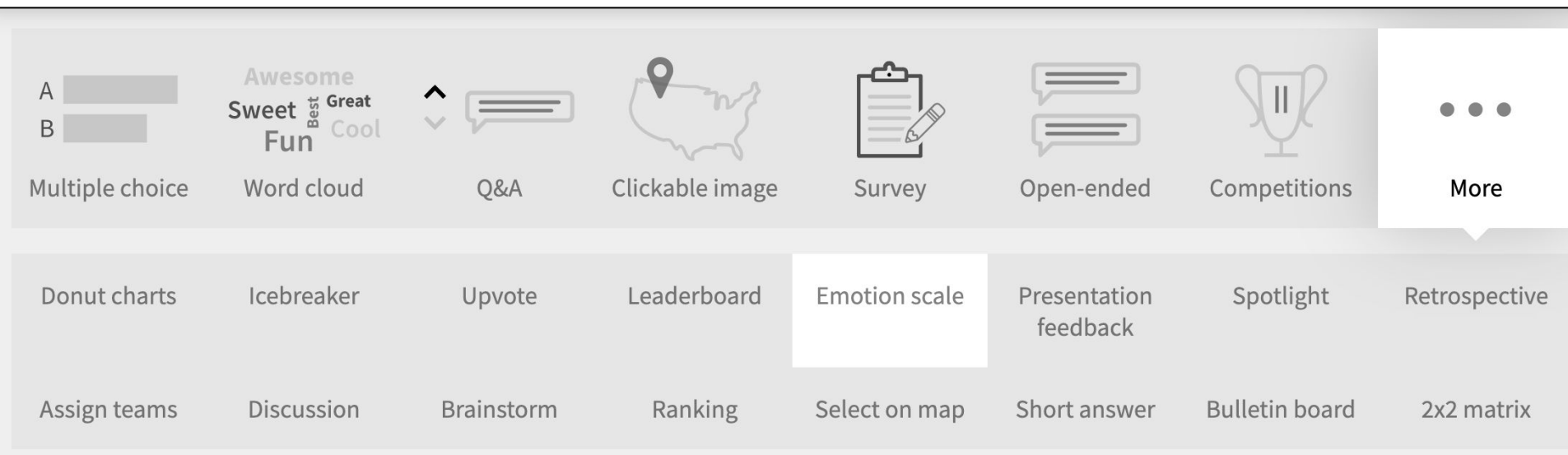

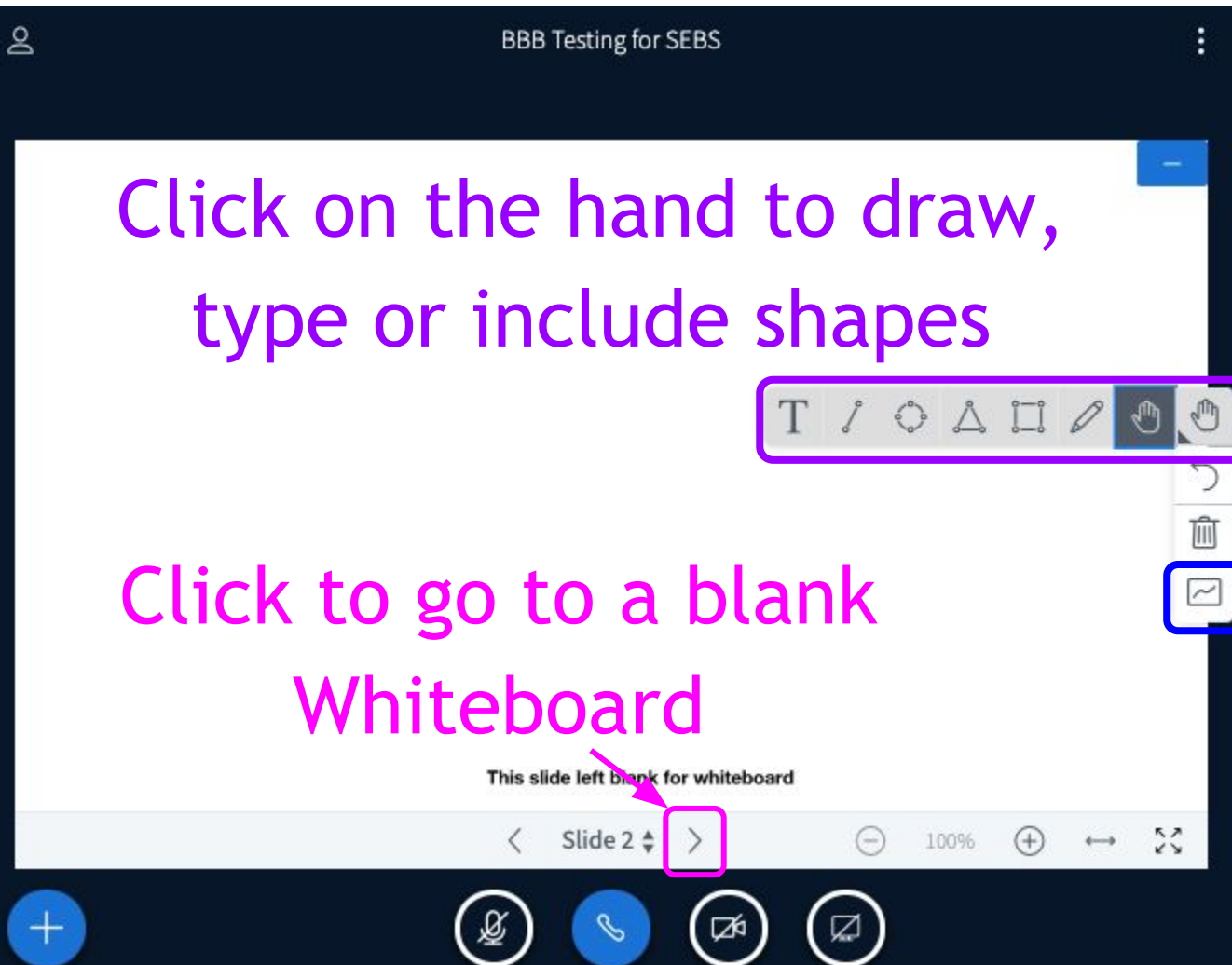

Other Features of Canvas/Sakai Conferences: BigBlueButton

Polling gives you the option of just providing answer choices (so you don't have to write entire question)

Click the + to upload a presentation, share a video or start a poll
