





- You can use break-out rooms to organize this in an synchronous format






### Other Features of Canvas/Sakai Conferences: BigBlueButton

### Other Features of Canvas/Sakai Conferences: BigBlueButton

Polling gives you the option of just providing answer choices (so you don't have to write entire question)

Canvas: 5GB Storage (Can be increased upon request)


